Consultation on the Aberdeen Local Development Plan – Main Issues Report began on 13 January and runs until 24 March 2014. ## Aberdeen Local Development Plan Scheme 2014

The Aberdeen Local Development Plan Scheme 2014 was approved by the Enterprise, Strategic Planning and Infrastructure Committee on 21 January 2014. This sets out the programme for preparing and reviewing the new Plan. It also explains who will be consulted and when, and sets out when the key decisions will be made. The Development Plan Scheme is available for inspection in Marischal College and at the City's public libraries.

The key stages identified in the Development Plan Scheme are:

- Proposed Local Development Plan to be published in February 2015
- Local Plan Examination to start in November 2015
- Adoption of the 2016 Local Development Plan in November/December 2016
